

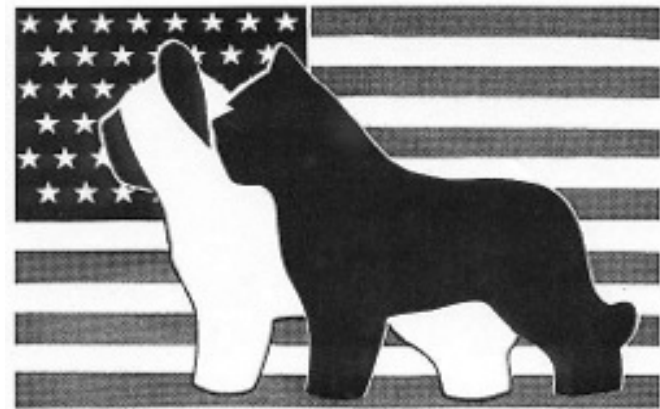
Entries open on Monday, June 24, 2024, at 8:00 AM ET at the Herding Secretary's Office.

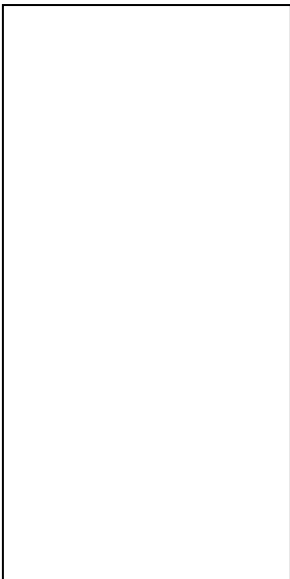

Trial Regulations

Alternates: Once a test or trial class has reached the numerical limit, an alternate list will be maintained. Entrants on the alternate list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to start of trial each day. Alternates that do not have an opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.

Refund: Entries pulled prior to closing will receive a full refund.

Entries pulled after the closing date will not receive any refund.

Proof of current rabies vaccination must be furnished upon request.

All dogs must be held on leash, except during their runs. Dogs must be kept a suitable distance away from the test area. Handlers should bring water and provide shade for their dogs. Handlers are required to pick up after their dogs

General Entry Information

A dog will earn an AKC Farm Dog Certificate (FDC) by qualifying under two different judges at two separate licensed or member Farm Dog Tests. The same is true for a **Herding Instinct Certificate (HIC)**. With the judges available over the weekend, a dog can earn both an FDC and an HIC

Entry fees: \$45 for each entry for Farm Dog; \$45 for Instinct Test; \$65 for Pre-Trial; \$80 for Course C

For online entries, instructions will show on the online entry form as your total is tabulated.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Herding Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with an international money order guaranteed in U.S. funds.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable. Telephone, telegraph, fax, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing date.

The club may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

GPS Coordinates: [42.30950, -71.98013] Look for a red barn on top of a hill opposite to a large white house. Enter the farm on the barn side of the road.

From Paxton center: Take Rte 31 West for 2.9 miles. The farm is on the left. Be careful about the reduced visibility on top of the hill, when entering the farm.

From Spencer center: Take Rte 31 North for 5.5 miles. The farm is on the right.

AGREEMENT

I (we) certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event and by any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list for this event.

Further, in consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons, to other dogs, or to livestock. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient.

I (we) agree to pay for any facility damages incurred by the actions of myself (ourselves) or my dog. I (we) agree to pay for any livestock injuries or replacement value in the event of death of any livestock by my (our) dog. In case if any injury to any stock caused by the dog entered, I (we) agree to assume total responsibility for any damage. I (we) agree to pay the veterinarian bill for the injury to the livestock or the full market value of the injured animal in case of serious injury. I (we) agree that the bill for any such damages is to be determined by the stock/property owner.
