## Awards Of Merit

Awards of Merit may be awarded at BCA approved regional specialties and the BCA National Specialty under the following guidelines:

All Grand Champion Select and BCA Awards of Merit are strictly at the judge's discretion.

The Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex, having received the highest honors possible, shall not receive a BCA Award of Merit. If Grand Champion Select are given they shall not receive a BCA Award of Merit.

The maximum number of Grand Champion Selects and BCA Awards of Merit combined that the judge at a Specialty shall be able to award will be based on the actual number of dogs in the ring for the intersex (BOB) competition.

3 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 1 GC Select\* awards  
4 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 2 GC Select\* awards  
5-10 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 2 GC Select \* or 1 AOM awards  
11-20 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 2 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
21-30 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 3 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
31-40 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 4 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
41-50 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 5 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
51-60 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 6 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
61-70 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 7 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
71-80 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 8 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
81-90 dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 9 GC Select \*/AOM awards  
91 or more dogs in ring for intersex competition – up to 10 GC Select \*/AOM awards

At the judge's discretion, a maximum of 6 Grand Champion Select and BCA Awards of Merit combined may be awarded at a Regional Specialty; a maximum of 10 Grand Champion Select and BCA Awards of Merit combined awarded at a National Specialty.

\*Note - Per AKC Grand Champion Rules, only dogs and bitches that have earned their Championship and are moved up to the Best of Breed as well as winners (Champions) from the Non-Regular classes would be eligible to compete on the day. Neither Winners Dog nor Winners Bitch is eligible to compete. Class dogs winning BOB or BOS will still allow the awarding of Select Dog/Bitch to eligible dogs in the ring. Additionally, only one dog and one bitch can be chosen Grand Champion Select.

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## Multiple Dog Entries – National Specialty Only

**Stud Dog Class** – For Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined in order to determine if a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Stud Dog does not need to be entered in a regular or non – regular class, but the get must be entered in a regular or non-regular class.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class** – For two dogs having at least one owner in common. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for “Brace Class Only”. When making entries for “Brace Class Only” full particulars must be given on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, “Brace Class” If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be identified as Brace #1, Brace #2, etc

**PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

The Sweepstakes is open to all Briards who are 6 months and under 24 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$15.00

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Neutered dogs & Spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and age division on the regular entry form under Additional Classes. Entry fee is \$15.00

This is a recorded event by the AKC for the Certificate of Merit and Puppy of Achievement certificates.

**Section 1 - Classifications** The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the first day of the event. Classes will be offered for breed and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows

**Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility** For additional information on entry and eligibility requirement, please see the Sanctioned Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations available on the AKC website at:

*AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC. Phone (919) 816-3776.*

***Entry Blank MUST be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Jr Showmanship will not be accepted***

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show who have not won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and have won three First Places in a Novice Class.

**Master Class:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with Competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year.

## SHOW REGULATIONS

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, after the entries have closed, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

Make all Checks and Money Orders payable to BCA, Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. All entries are to be mailed with fees to Lori Carver, Secretary, PO Box 1204, Belchertown, MA 01007. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Secretary.

An Event Service Fee and a recording fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show giving clubs shall charge \$15 Processing Fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds.

Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent. This club and its Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which it is not eligible to compete, or for entering the dog twice.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. There is no refund for duplicate entries. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show-giving club is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles.

The Show-giving Club is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or personal property.
